South Carolina Women's Match Game

Tournament Rules

Qualifying Date: October 30, 2010

Location: Sandpiper Lanes, N. Charleston, SC

1. This tournament is a USBC certified event (#04685). Participants must be female members of the USBC and a local South Carolina association. Bowlers must have an average of at least twenty-one (21) games in a South Carolina association league for the 2009–2010 season, or the 2010 summer season. A league secretary or manager of the local association must verify membership and average requirement. Current members of the WPBA may enter, provided they meet the local association membership requirement.
2. **Final "Reserve Entry Fee" Postmark Deadline is October 16, 2010. The Fee is \$100.00** (\$75.00 prize fund, \$20.00 bowling fee, \$5.00 expense fee). Contestants may enter at the tournament site on October 30, 2010, from 9:30 am – 11:30 am on a first come, first served basis. **Entry fee after October 16, 2010 will be \$115.00.** (*The additional \$15.00 will serve as a late processing fee and be used to increase the Prize Fund.*)
Entries taken on October 30 2010, must be accompanied by this entry form, completed as instructed, with a CASH ONLY payment.

A \$30.00 fee will be assessed for any check returned to the SC USBC Assoc. for nonpayment.

3. This is a scratch tournament. Each participant will bowl two (2) three-game qualifying blocks with the top six (6) qualifiers advancing to the match play finals. Points are earned based on the number of pins over or under scratch of 180. Qualifying scores will be carried forward to the match play finals. In case of a tie for sixth (6th) place, there will be a one (1) game roll-off immediately following the competition of qualifying. Seventh (7th) place will serve as the alternate and must be present on Sunday and collect scores to receive the alternate's prize money. In the event that there are twenty-four (24) or more participants, the contestants will have a vote on having eight finalists with the ninth being the alternate. This would necessitate eight match games, one against each the other seven finalists, with the eighth game being a position round. **If there are twelve (12) or fewer contestants, only the top four (4) qualifiers will compete in match play, with the fifth being the alternate and adjustments made accordingly.**
4. Match play finals will be scratch with thirty (30) bonus pins awarded to the winner of each game. Each bowler will bowl the other five (5) finalists once, with the sixth (6th) game being a position round. A one game roll-off will determine the winner, if there is a tie for First Place at the end of the sixth (6th) game. The champion will receive a championship plaque in addition to 1st place money.

Bowling money in excess of the required amount to pay for lineage will be added to the Prize Fund.

5. The tournament director has the authority to disqualify any contestant for unsportsmanlike conduct during the tournament and to make decisions regarding tournament play.
6. **Proper attire** is required and includes shirts with collars, blouses (mock collars are allowed) and dress slacks, skirts or skorts. Shirts with collars (or mock collars) and blouses are allowed, along with dress slacks, skirts, knee length shorts or skorts. **From USBC:** Participants may not wear tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, tube tops, workout attire (Spandex or sweatpants), spaghetti strap tops, short shorts or skirts (if a bowler's fingers are below the hemline, the shorts are considered too short and not suitable), bib overalls, torn or unclean jeans, shirts or T-shirts with offensive language or pictures, nor hats and head coverings (except for medical reasons)..
